Gov. Richard Lamm Joins MRFF's Advisory Board



Mikey Weinstein, MRFF's president and founder, announced this week that Richard D. Lamm, former governor of Colorado, will join MRFF's advisory board.

Lamm is co-director of the Institute for Public Policy Studies at the University of Denver, and the former three-term Governor of Colorado. He is both a lawyer (Berkeley, 1961) and a Certified Public Accountant. He joined the faculty of the University of Denver in 1969 and has, except for his years as Governor, been associated with the University ever since.

"I am honored that Governor Lamm has accepted the invitation to join our advisory board," said Mikey Weinstein MRFF's president and founder. "I believe that his background and experiences both in the political and academic arenas will greatly benefit MRFF's cause and help bring us closer to

fulfilling our goals of protecting the honorable men and women who serve in our nation's armed forces."

A Note From MRFF's President



I have spent much of the past two months on the road, travelling to meet with diverse groups of people interested in the Foundation's efforts.

In Washington, DC, I addressed the Jewish Council for Public Affairs annual conference and also spent a week in New York on a whirlwind speaking and fundraising "tour."

In San Antonio, I was honored to speak at the first- ever CONUS Trial Advocacy Conference for active duty Air Force trial and defense lawyers.

In the past, Air Force trial prosecutors and defense counsels assigned within the United States had gathered for training and military law updates in smaller groups throughout the United States. The conference was the first time that this group gathered in one location for such an annual meeting. Over 100 members of the Air Force defense community and over 45 Air Force prosecutors attended the event.

Speaking at the CONUS conference was an extraordinary opportunity to address those already familiar with military law. I hope to have the chance to meet with and address similar groups in the near future.
