Notwithstanding your letter, it would appear that three of the four petitions on the ACLJ website have been modified so as to remove words like “angry atheists” and so as not to specifically name Mikey Weinstein or the Foundation. We appreciate those changes having been made.

The fourth petition, however, concerning the POW/MIA tables, has not yet been changed and still refers to the Foundation as “angry atheists.”

Attached for reference is a list of articles still on the website that directly refer to the Foundation as atheists. We would appreciate your calling these to the attention of Mr. Sekulow.

Please also pass on to him our thanks for making the changes that have been made and reminding him that Mr. Weinstein remains open to engaging in full public debate with him concerning matters of interest to both.
